What is ADHD?

Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) is a brain-based disorder that is first diagnosed in childhood which affects children and adolescents, and can continue through adulthood. ADHD can interfere with the functioning and development of a person.

3 Types of ADHD:

Inattentive type- has difficulty staying organized and focusing.

Hyperactive-Impulsive type- is constantly active, fidgets, taps or talks excessively. Acts without first thinking, interrupts others, and/or has an inability to control emotions.

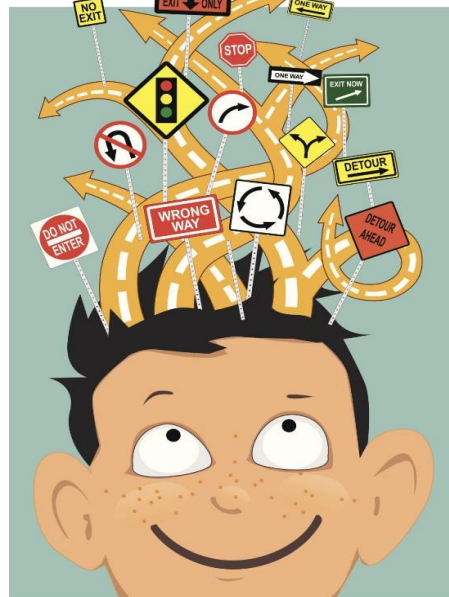
Combined type- has symptoms of both inattentive and hyperactive-impulsive type. It is the most common type of ADHD.

Signs and Symptoms

- Hyperactivity
- Impulsivity
- Inattentiveness
- Forgetfulness
- Acting without thinking
- Excessive talking
- Lack of concentration

Risk Factors

- Genes
- Low birth weight
- Brain injuries
- Environmental exposure to toxins during pregnancy
- Environmental exposure to lead or pesticides at a young age



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DID YOU KNOW?
Males are 3 times more likely to be diagnosed with ADHD than females.

Six ways to help

1. Keeping a routine
2. Homework and notebook organizers
3. Organizing everyday items
4. Being clear and consistent
5. Praise and rewards when rules are followed
6. Reminder Notes
